4. Parks, Recreation and Arts Updates

- Tom reviewed Winter Projects
 - working on pavement at CVAC and putting in concrete pavers in the Amphitheater.
- Kevin Schuh was promoted to Sports and Wellness Superintendent (promote more sports and competitions at the Complex).
- Tree plantings throughout the city
- Still waiting on the paperwork for The Awakening and grounds to become part of Central Park.
- Darcy is Emeritus Status, approved by Council (up to 3 years)
- Senior programs are in the works
- Hiring 60 lifeguards for the pool this summer
- Pedal the Cause will be back

Summer concerts (Tribute bands - Billy Joel, Police, Neil Diamond)

- o Ticket sales are doing well
- o River City Blue Grass Festival (May 17th & 18th)
- o July 3rd show confirmed (to be announced soon)

Taste of St. Louis: Company has been purchased, moving back to the city by Soldier's Memorial.
3 new "walks" for charity, coming to Chesterfield in 2019. A couple in the fall as well.

5. Unfinished Business

- Alan P. – Any news on acquisitioned property?
 - o Tom mentioned 3 pieces of land on the consideration list:
 - o Schoettler (just south of Logan)
 - o Gail Hill's Property - 9 ½ acres
 - o Property on West side of Railroad Park (13 acres), easier accessibility to the park. It would allow easier access.
- Rob had questions on three items, looking for an update:
- *What's the update on Zero Hero?*
 - o Tom spoke with Beaver Creek, still waiting on return call from Environmental Services director to return his call (it is labor intensive, from what he knows with a substantial cost to the Parks Budget). Recycle bins are in progress (thanks to a grant).
 - o Trend is "Come with your trash. Take your trash home". That can be a substantial savings.
- *Saks Property at Wildhorse Creek/Baxter*
 - o Tom had a conversation. They are not interested
- *Moving billboard, LED touchscreens for comprehensive list of activities*
 - o Tom, we don't have the budget. Improvement of App is in progress.
