1. Approval of October 9th, 2021 Meeting Results – Meeting was called to order by Chair Mike Whelan at 8:15. Minutes were reviewed and approved.
2. Central Park Update – The Parks, Recreation and Arts Committee of City Council and the full City Council granted approval to proceed with the following projects in Central Park: construction of the Loop Road and sidewalks, main field grading, lighting and Pickleball courts. It was noted that the location of the Pickleball courts may be changed. Mark Ivancic noted that Pickleball popularity continues to increase and is also attracting younger age groups.
3. Logan Park – Phase I plan in process and the City is working with MSD to resolve some issues. Phase II Planning Grant has been approved. This will include trails, a native garden, shade structures, 2 pickleball courts and other amenities.

4. Art location for Sculpture on the Move – Tom distributed a list of potential locations and encouraged the committee to recommend other locations. Charlie Foxman suggested the area of Justus Post Road and Chesterfield Parkway.
5. Don Collins Memorial – Contact Tom McCarthy, Rob Kilo, or Mike Whelan with suggestions for a memorial. Barbara Briggs asked about a Chesterfield Citizen of the Year nomination. Mike Whelan discussed the criteria for this award which should be Chesterfield centric.
6. Kilo Art Donation Project – Tabled until next meeting to get an update from Rob Kilo.
7. Holiday Tree Lighting – Event planned for December 4th at Central Park and will include a Santa Dash, Candy Cane Hunt and Tree Lighting ceremony. Volunteers needed. Email Tom or Kari if you can assist.
8. Nominations for Chair, Vice Chair and Secretary – Email Tom if you are interested in nominating someone or yourself for one of these positions. Elections will be held during the first meeting of 2022.
9. Unfinished Business – None.
10. New Business – Tom distributed the tentative 2022 meeting schedule. All meetings will be Wednesday evenings at 6:15 PM due to poor attendance on Saturday mornings. Committee members need to attend 50% of the meetings that take place.
