COUNCIL COMMITTEE REPORTS

Planning/Public Works Committee

Councilmember Connie Fults, Chairperson of the Planning/Public Works Committee, reported that Bill No. 2946 (P.Z. 01-2013, Arbors at Kehrs Mill) will be considered for adoption under the “Legislation – Planning Commission” portion of the agenda. Super Majority vote required for passage.

Councilmember Fults reported that Bill No. 2947 (P.Z. 02-2013, Arbors at Kehrs Mill) will be considered for adoption under the “Legislation – Planning Commission” portion of the agenda. Super Majority vote required for passage.

Councilmember Fults reported that Bill No. 2954 (Amends Ordinance #2732 Pertaining to Open House Directional Signs) will be read for the first time under the “Legislation” portion of the agenda. This bill will rescind the sunset clause and would allow Saturday Open House signs indefinitely.

Councilmember Fults announced that the next meeting of this Committee, scheduled for Thursday, November 21, at 5:30 p.m., has been canceled.

LEGISLATION

BILL NO. 2954	REPEALS SECTION 2.5-4 PERTAINING TO OFF PREMISE RESIDENTIAL REAL ESTATE OPEN HOUSE DIRECTIONAL SIGNS; AND TO ESTABLISH NEW RULES FOR THE
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REGULATION AND PLACEMENT OF RESIDENTIAL REAL
ESTATE OPEN HOUSE SIGNS WITHIN THE CITY OF
CHESTERFIELD, MISSOURI (**FIRST READING;
PLANNING/PUBLIC WORKS COMMITTEE
RECOMMENDS APPROVAL**)

Councilmember Fults made a motion, seconded by Councilmember DeGroot, for the first reading of Bill No. 2954. Councilmember Flachsbart stated that he voted against this in Committee because, while he favors the possibility of one-year extensions, he does not believe it is appropriate to remove the sunset clause permanently. A voice vote was taken with an affirmative result (Councilmember Flachsbart voted “No”) and the motion was declared passed. Bill No. 2954 was read for the first time.

LEGISLATION – PLANNING COMMISSION

BILL NO. 2946 REPEALS THE ZONING ORDINANCE 2322 OF THE CITY OF CHESTERFIELD BY CHANGING THE BOUNDARIES OF AN “E-2” ESTATE DISTRICT (TWO ACRE) AND “LLR” LARGE LOT RESIDENTIAL DISTRICT TO AN “E-1” ESTATE DISTRICT (ONE ACRE) FOR A 41.082 ACRE TRACT OF LAND LOCATED NORTH OF THE INTERSECTION OF CHURCH RD. AND STRECKER RD. (P.Z. 01-2013 ARBORS AT KEHRS MILL {17015 CHURCH RD.} 19U420248). (**SECOND READING; PLANNING COMMISSION RECOMMENDS APPROVAL; DEFEATED AT 10/21/2013 COUNCIL MEETING; MOTION TO RECONSIDER APPROVED AT 11/4/2013 COUNCIL MEETING; SUPER MAJORITY VOTE REQUIRED FOR PASSAGE**)

Councilmember Fults made a motion, seconded by Councilmember Grissom, for the second reading of Bill No. 2946. A voice vote was taken with an affirmative result (Councilmember Hurt voted “No”) and the motion was declared passed. Bill No. 2946 was read for the second time. Councilmembers Fults and Flachsbart stated that they will vote in favor of Bill No. 2946 and Bill No. 2947 because it is a significant improvement to the zoning that currently exists for this property. Councilmember Greenwood added that the Planning Commission unanimously recommended Bill No. 2946 and Bill No. 2947 because it is superior to the existing zoning. Councilmember Fults also indicated her intention to vote “yes” for both pieces of legislation, for the same reasons. A roll call vote was taken for the passage and approval of Bill No. 2946 with the following results: Ayes – Fults, Greenwood, Grier, Grissom, Flachsbart and Casey. Nays – Hurt and DeGroot. Whereupon Mayor Nation declared Bill No. 2946 approved, passed it and it became **ORDINANCE NO. 2770**.

BILL NO. 2947 REPEALS THE ZONING ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF CHESTERFIELD BY CHANGING THE BOUNDARIES OF AN “E-1” ESTATE DISTRICT (ONE ACRE) TO A “PUD” PLANNED

UNIT DEVELOPMENT FOR A 58.149 ACRE TRACT OF LAND LOCATED NORTH OF THE INTERSECTION OF CHURCH RD. AND STRECKER RD. (P.Z. 02-2013 ARBORS AT KEHRS MILL {17015 CHURCH RD.} 19U420248). **(SECOND READING; PLANNING COMMISSION RECOMMENDS APPROVAL; DEFEATED AT 10/21/2013 COUNCIL MEETING; MOTION TO RECONSIDER APPROVED AT 11/4/2013 COUNCIL MEETING; SUPER MAJORITY VOTE REQUIRED FOR PASSAGE)**

Councilmember Fults made a motion, seconded by Councilmember Flachsbart, for the second reading of Bill No. 2947. A voice vote was taken with an affirmative result (Councilmember Hurt voted “No”) and the motion was declared passed. Bill No. 2947 was read for the second time. A roll call vote was taken for the passage and approval of Bill No. 2947 with the following results: Ayes – Grissom, Flachsbart, Greenwood, Grier, Casey and Fults. Nays – Hurt and DeGroot. Whereupon Mayor Nation declared Bill No. 2947 approved, passed it and it became **ORDINANCE NO. 2771**.

ADJOURNMENT

There being no further business to discuss, Mayor Nation adjourned the meeting at 7:57 p.m.
