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- I. Approval of Sept 14 Meeting Results
 - a. Amend spelling errors
 - b. All ayes on corrected minutes
- II. Trail and Connectivity Subcommittee Update (Kelli Unnerstall)
 - a. Mission to update the bikeable walkable plan from 2010.
 - b. Priorities by ward: Pedestrian Improvement Zones
 - i. Ward 1 - Olive East (Olive from 141 to River Valley Dr.: crosswalks, bikeable, sidewalks disconnected and missing), Olive West (Faust Park access) — vote favored Olive east as priority (on second vote)
 - ii. Ward 2 - Clarkson/Olive along retail development, Chesterfield Parkway, Conway all the way from Parkway to Town & Country — vote favored Clarkson/Olive
 - iii. Ward 3 - Schoettler Rd
 - iv. Ward 4 - Wildhorse Creek East (stoplight or pedestrian on-demand signal at Benton Taylor Drive) - August Hill and Lydia Hill drive, in addition to disconnected sidewalks along Wildhorse Creek, Baxter Road bridge over Bonhomme Creek lacks any pedestrian or bike access. Also add bike/pedestrian access from Chesterfield Crossing to cross the highway to the Monarch Levee Trail. — vote favored Wildhorse Creek East, inc. crosswalk at Benton Taylor Drive, then Baxter Road bridge over Bonhomme Creek as second priority.
 - c. Trail priorities by ward
 - i. Ward 1 - Missouri Greenway (GRG)
 - ii. Ward 2 - Ameren Trail South
 - iii. Ward 3 - Ameren Trail South, Straub Hill - High School Connector
 - iv. Ward 4 - Monarch Levee Trail - complete east loop, add restroom/table at Long & Edison Road trailhead, raise section under Highway 40/64 near Daniel Boone Bridge to keep it open during floods, add mileage markers on trail. Add access to trail from Edison Avenue near Boone's Crossing.

 - b. 10-12 wide gravel trail, 12' wide maintained along each side.
