C. NWF

1. Report on Invasive Honeysuckle removal at Chesterfield Elementary- Cleaned out a lot of honeysuckle. However, we still had to leave some huge ones behind. So there is still more work to do. Removed a total of five and half yards with 31 people in 3 hours. West News will have a report in their next issue.
2. Telephone Conference Update- Teleconference concentrated on our community event ideas. They suggested annual events that people can count on. NWF is aware of BDSTL and may be a future partner. Tentatively, they will be sending a STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Math) judge from their Texas office for earth day youth in science competition.
