3. Exhibit Request from St. John’s United Church of Christ for Sunday, October 11 – Darcy. (need 2 volunteers: 9:15 set up, ends 11:15 a.m.) *Darcy and Scott will represent the Committee.*
4. 13th America/Missouri/Chesterfield Recycles Day: **WHY We Recycle. It ALL Comes Back to You on 11/14!** - Jeanne, Ted, Donna.
 - a. CCE Table – Donna. *Donna has requested suggestions for posters and brochures to be displayed.*
 - b. Mounted Street Signs – Darcy. *Will investigate transporting the sample street signs kept at Darcy’s house for display at the event.*
