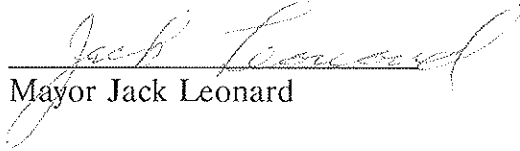

REPORT OF THE CITY CLERK

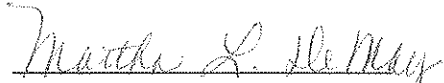
ADJOURNMENT
