B.Z. 1-2003 Liberty Homes: a request in variance from Section 1003.182 (Commercial Service Procedure) of the City of Chesterfield Zoning Ordinance to allow said procedure on Chesterfield Parkway East.

Petitioner Larry Mintz, has been a resident for 9 years in Chesterfield. He purchased the property at 996 E. Chesterfield Parkway. He owns his own windows and siding business and would like to run this business out of this house. The business will be called Liberty. There will be no storage at this facility. He has 4-5 employees, and would have no more than 6 cars on the lot. The house is a 50 years old building, he will not change the structure of the house but keep it looking as is and keeping up the landscaping. There are currently other

businesses around this property. Behind this property are apartments, one house to the south, one house to the west and a synagogue across the street. The existing setbacks would be the hardship if going to a commercial zoned property.
