APPROVAL OF MEETING MINUTES- minutes were approved from the January 16, 2018, meeting summary. Voice vote of 4-0.

- 1. Creative Arts Alliance, Art Location Recommendation-** A motion to approve was made to send the recommendation from the Parks, Recreation and Arts Advisory Committee on the public art piece Saturday's Distraction, and the recommended location for installation at the CVAC forward to the full Council at the next meeting on Monday March 19 for their approval to move forward with the installation. The motion passed 4-0.
- 2. 1859 Schoettler Road Park Opportunity-** The appraisal report was discussed that was done by Ann McReynolds for the City after Director McCarthy was instructed to get an appraisal at the August 7, 2017 executive session. McReynolds appraisal came in at \$900,000 verse the Dodge appraisal that came in at \$1,510,000 that was provided by Hassan Jadali the realtor for the property owners. A motion was made by Randy Logan and second by Ben Keathley to move the appraisal information on to the full Council for discussion in executive session on Monday, March 19, 2018. The motion passed 4-0. Along with the discussion on the appraisal Director McCarthy was asked by Council member McGuinness to put together a history on the cities use of the McReynolds Reality appraisal group for future information.
